Parking inappropriately can be dangerous for children

Please don't park on:

- Single yellow lines, double yellow lines or zig zag road markings outside a school; they are there to ensure that sight lines are clear for both passing motorists and children who are crossing the road.
- The pavement; it makes it difficult for people with pushchairs and wheelchair users to get past.
- Dropped kerbs or on people's drives; if you park there you're putting children at risk of an accident.

If you do need to drive, try car sharing or parking nearby and walking the rest of the way. Or why not try walking, cycling or scooting to school – even if it's just once or twice a week!

Children should never have to cross the road between parked cars outside their school!
