CROSSMALK

Street by street, follow a walk around the centre of York. Each clue leads you to the next street.

Start outside the **Visit York Information Centre**.

The first clue is 'Follow the poet away from the Places'. Which street name does that suggest? The street will be visible from where you're standing, so you won't have many to choose from. Make sure you read the next clue before you start walking and check every junction as you walk down a street, as you may not be on some streets for long.

Clue 14 (**in bold**) is for a **building**, not a street.





With each clue there are two numbers. The first tells you which letter from the answer you need to note down. The second tells you where in the phrase it sits. For 'Visit York', (1) indicates that 'V' is the letter you need to note down. The (7) indicates that it is the seventh letter in the Crosswalk phrase, as shown in the solution grid below.
